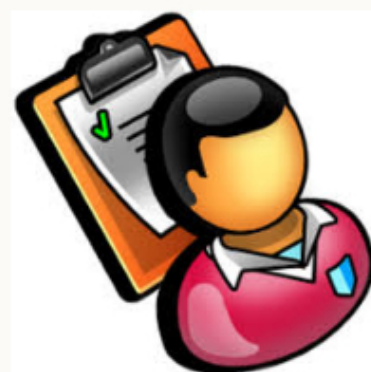

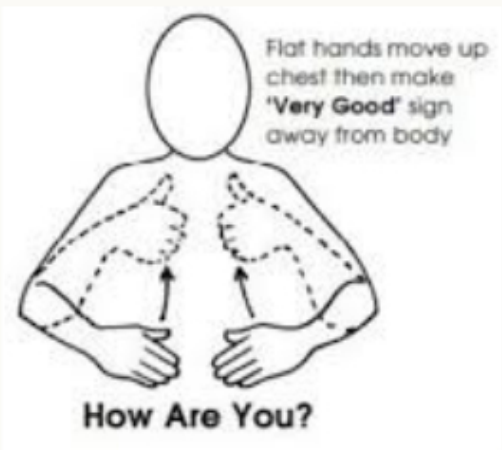
Every Tuesday 3-4pm is our extended school afternoon.

Children take part in a vast range of clubs including photography. Here is some of their work on texture.

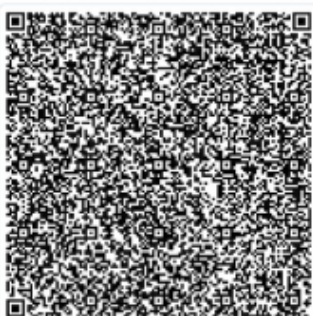


Sign of the week
